

The Committee files this Form-99 as a supplemental response to the RFAI regarding the 2010 June Monthly Report (5/1/10 - 5/31/10).

1. In response to the letter dated July 30, 2010 requesting additional information as to Schedule A supporting Line 15 of the report, payments from a federal candidate committee(s) for goods and/or services provided by [the] committee, this response is to serve as notification that the amount charged to federal candidate committees were of a fair market value.
  
2. Based upon the market value of the cost of data in Delaware, all statewide candidates paid the fair market value for the voter file data. All non-statewide candidates pay a pro-rata cost for data depending on the size of the district involved. The cost for the non-statewide candidates' voter file data is of a fair market value.
  
3. Also, the rent charged to the federal candidate committees is the fair market value determined through a calculation of square footage of the office space as well as other utilities included.

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
