Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Please provide a Schedule C or D, as appropriate, to support the entry of \$11,691.18 reported on Line 10 of the Summary Page. Loans and debts must be continuously reported until they are either repaid or settled. 11 CFR §104.3(d)

-Your report discloses limited payments for administrative expenses. Each committee utilizing separate federal and non-federal accounts is required to allocate any administrative expenses between the accounts in proportion to the BALLOT COMPOSITION METHOD derived from FEC Schedule H1. See 11 CFR §106.5(d)

(By checking the appropriate boxes on the Method of Allocation Schedule H1, committees calculate a federal allocation percentage based on the ratio of federal offices expected on the ballot to total federal and non-federal offices expected on the ballot in the next election. The Schedule H1 must be filed with FORM 3X submitted each year.)

In addition, Schedules H3 and H4 must be filed to properly allocate administrative costs between accounts on reports filed during the year. Please refer to 11 CFR §§106.5 and 104.10(b)(1).

-On Schedule H4 supporting Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page, you have failed to include a total for EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE for a payment(s) to all vendors. Please amend your report to include the missing EVENT YEAR-TO-DATE total(s).
