Dear Mr. Harper:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule A of your report discloses a receipt totaling \$5,762.21 from "MWH Americas Inc. Employee PAC" for "Interest" which requires further clarification. If this transaction(s) represents the "internal transfer" of funds from one federal account to another, and the source of such funds has been identified in previous reports of receipts and disbursements, please note that such transfers should not be itemized as doing so inflates total receipts and causes a discrepancy in the cash on hand amount. If this is the case, please amend your report accordingly. If the receipt in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with clarifying information.

Please provide clarification regarding the ultimate source of these funds. Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding any impermissible activity, your prompt clarification or corrective action will be taken into consideration.

-Schedule B supporting Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page discloses contributions totaling \$5,000 to "Jay C. Hoffman" for the 2006 Primary election. However, it appears that this candidate's principle campaign committee was terminated in 1999 and is no longer registered with the


Commission. Please amend your report to provide further clarification regarding this committee.

-Your report disclosed a category of financial activity that has been reflected on the wrong line of the Detailed Summary Page. Contributions for non-federal candidates/committees should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule B, supporting Line 29 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions for each line when determining the proper categorization(s) for your next filing.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
