Dear Mr. Jones,

Thank you for your letter dated November 6. You were correct in that our Joint Fundraising disclosures in Schedule A contained memos for receipts from our July quarterly report. We reported these to ensure that our total memos of receipts for the second and third quarter would completely disclose our total transfers from the Joint Fundraisers. The aggregate memos from the second and third quarter total to an excess of the total transfers in second and third quarter. In addition, we have very carefully reported the actual cash transfers for each period (second and third quarter) and for each election cycle (primary and general), so the cash flow for the committee remains as stated. I spoke with Travis Brown about this issue on November 26th and outlined how we reported the memos and transfers. He felt that additional schedules would only confuse the matter, and we agreed that I would write this letter in response, with no additional schedules attached.
