Re: Letter dated October 14, 2005, regarding Amended 30 Day Post-General Report (10/14/04-11/22/04), received on July 25, 2005

The remaining portion of the disbursement to GCR & Associates which totaled \$15,585.30, paid for automated telephone calls to Louisiana residents encouraging them to vote by absentee ballot in the 2004 general election. Because the telephone calls did not identify any candidates, the payment was for "get-out-the-vote activity." See 2 U.S.C. 431(20); 11 C.F.R. 100.24(a)(3). The Party has amended the Post-General Report by listing the remaining balance of the payment to GCR & Associates on Schedule B supporting Line 30(b). See 2 U.S.C. 431(20); 11 C.F.R. 100.24; F.E.C. Instructions for Form 3X (Dec. 2004).

The disbursements to AT&T Wireless, which were misclassified as "federal election activity" in the original Post General Report, paid for phone banking activity urging Louisiana residents to vote in support of several federal candidates. See 2 U.S.C. 431(24); 11 C.F.R. 100.28. The Party has disclosed candidate information and payment addresses for each of these independent expenditures, as well for the payments to GCR & Associates, on the amended report.

Finally, the Commission requested that the Party identify the designating committees for certain coordinated party expenditures listed on Schedule F of the Post General Report. The Party has disclosed the Tauzin for Congress Campaign as the designating committee for payments to Screen Printing Express and American Solutions for Business.
