Dear Mr. Holliday:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Please provide a Schedule H3 to support the entry reported on Line 18 of the Detailed Summary Page. All transfers received from a committee's non-federal account for joint activity must be itemized on Schedule H3 regardless of the amount transferred. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(3)(D)

-Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page discloses joint federal/non-federal operating expenditures during the reporting period. Committees must itemize each allocated disbursement made from its federal account or separate allocation account regardless of the amount. Please amend your report(s) by itemizing the expenditures on Schedule H4. 11 CFR §104.10

-Line 21(b) of the Detailed Summary Page discloses operating expenditures during the reporting period. Please amend your report to clarify whether this figure includes any disbursements to payees that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. If this is the case, itemize the expenditures on Schedule B. 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3)

-On Schedule D of your previous report, you disclosed a debt(s) owed to B. R. Hilton Hotel/Davidson Hotel Co. This obligation(s), however, has been

omitted from this report. Please amend your report to include this debt(s) on Schedule D and Line 10 of the Summary Page. All debts and obligations must be disclosed until extinguished. 11 CFR §104.11


-Schedule D discloses the outstanding balance at the close of the period for the debt owed to Baton Rouge Marriott to be \$181. FEC calculations disclose this amount to be \$1,681. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

-It has come to the attention of the Federal Election Commission that the reports you have filed during the current election cycle do not reflect the appropriate coverage dates for quarterly filing status. Please be advised of the filing dates and coverage periods for the 2001-2002 election cycle and fill in the appropriate dates on Line 5 of the Summary Page.
