

This response is to answer questions raised by the Federal Election Commission's ("FEC") notification, dated June 12, 2002, regarding information reported on the above referenced report.

- Issue:** Column B totals/Summary and Detailed Summary Pages
- Response:** An amended report filed electronically on 06/17/02 properly discloses the Column B totals referenced in your correspondence.
- Issue:** Debts owed to Creditors
- Response:** An amended report filed electronically on 06/17/02 discloses the missing entries on Schedule D, Line 10 for those creditors referenced in your correspondence.
- Issue:** Non-Federal transfers for joint activity
- Response:** A committee is not required to make the non-federal to federal account transfers within a single reporting period for all joint activity expenditures made in that period. As noted in your correspondence, transfers for shared activity must be made within a 70-day time period. The non-federal transfers as reported on Schedule A, supporting Line 18 is higher than the non-federal share of joint activity for this reporting period due to the fact some of the transfers were for joint activity in the previous reporting period.
