

This Form 99 response is in response to the Commission's letter dated April 24, 2008, regarding the Committee's Year-End report. The contributions from Danita Knight and Paul C Rosser on the Year-End report were for the Runoff election and therefore, do not count toward their annual 2008 limits. The receipts from Abel Investments, LLC, Brooks Harvard LLC, Cherokee Nation Business, LLC, DAE, LLC/Glick Investments and Parks & Crump LLC were confirmed by the Joint Fundraiser representative to be from permissible sources. Receipts on Line 17 are for Voter File Purchases. The prices paid for the voter file purchases are established using comparable prices charged by other state party committees throughout the country on a per record cost. The exact price paid to the Committee by each entity is determined by multiplying the per record cost by the number of records provided in the file purchased, or a set price for a statewide voter file, also determined by the total number of records in the file. This is considered the "usual and normal charge" for the good provided. The receipt from Henson for Senate was for Voter File Purchases and was considered the "usual and normal charge" for the voter file purchased.
