Weber for Congress files the following in response to the RFAs referenced above.

The pre-general report will be amended as requested to provide appropriate purpose descriptions.

Regarding the amended October quarterly report, filed Oct. 24, 2012:

1. The contributions from Charles Medlin and Kent Watts were properly reattributed within 60 days of receipt and reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the post-general report. As reflected in the post-general, the Medlin contribution was reattributed by letter received Oct. 27, 2012 (signed by Charles and Patricia Medlin); the Watts contribution was reattributed by letter received Oct. 22, 2012 (signed by Fran and Kent Watts).
