Dear Custodian of Records:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the 24 Hour Notice of Disbursements/Obligations for Electioneering Communications (FEC Form 9) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** Additional information is needed for the following item:

- Commission regulations require that if the disbursements were paid exclusively from a segregated bank account consisting of funds provided solely by individuals who are United States citizens, United States nationals, or who are lawfully admitted for permanent residence under 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(20), the name and address of each donor who donated an amount aggregating \$1,000 or more to the segregated bank account, aggregating since the first day of the preceding calendar year is required. (11 CFR § 104.20 (c)(7)) In addition, if disbursements were not paid exclusively from a segregated bank account as described in 11 CFR § 104.20(c)(7), the name and address of each donor who donated an amount aggregating \$1,000 or more to the person making the disbursement, aggregating since the first day of the preceding calendar year is required. (11CFR § 104.20 (c)(8)) Please amend your report to provide the missing information.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee

will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
