-The total listed on Line 20, Column B of the Detailed Summary Page appears to be incorrect. Please be advised that you should add the "Calendar Year-to-Date" total from your previous report to the current "Total This Period" figure from Column A to derive the correct Column B total. Please amend your report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.

-Your calculations for Line 11(a)(iii), Column B appear to be incorrect. FEC calculations disclose this amount(s) to be \$26,125. Please provide the corrected total(s) on the Detailed Summary Page.

-Your report discloses no payments for administrative expenses. Administrative expenses are payments made for the purpose of operating a political committee including, but not limited to, rent, utilities, salaries, telephone service, office equipment and supplies. Any such payments to a person aggregating in excess of \$200 in a calendar year must be disclosed on Schedules H4 or B, supporting Lines 21(a) or 21(b), respectively of the Detailed Summary Page. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(5) In addition, if expenses have

been incurred but not paid in a reporting period, the activity should be disclosed as a debt on Schedule D, if the obligation is \$500 or more, or outstanding for sixty days or more. 11 CFR §104.11


