Dear Mr. DeWaal:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

- In the funds expended box for non-connected committees on Schedule H1, you have provided actual direct candidate support percentages for federal and non-federal candidates which do not equal 100% when added together.


Please be advised that administrative expenses and costs of generic voter drives made by nonconnected committees should be allocated according to the funds expended method. Under this method, expenses shall be allocated based on the ratio of federal expenditures to total federal and non-federal disbursements made by the committee during the two-year federal election cycle. This ratio shall be estimated and reported at the beginning of each federal election cycle, based upon the committee's federal and non-federal disbursements in a prior federal election cycle or upon the committee's reasonable prediction of its disbursements for the coming two years. Further, on each of its periodic reports, the committee shall adjust its allocation ratio to reconcile it with the ratio of actual federal to non-federal disbursements made (disbursements for specific candidates), to date.

Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy and to include an estimated funds expended ratio. 11 CFR §106.6 (c) (1) and (2)

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
