
-Your report discloses a returned contribution(s) from a federal candidate totaling -\$3,000.00 on Schedule B supporting Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page. If the recipient committee cashed your check and wrote a refund on its account, you should itemize the refund on Schedule A supporting Line 16. Negative entries on Schedule B should only be used if the check written by your committee was not cashed. Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy or provide clarification regarding this transaction.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
