



Thank you for calling to our attention the need to clarify the information as to the \$2,000 contribution made by Power Political Action Committee of Texas Utilities Company (Power PAC), under its former name Texas Utilities Company Power Political Action Committee, to the Phil Gramm presidential campaign.

We have written the finance director for this campaign advising her of your comments. As soon as they advise us of the appropriate disposition of these funds, we will amend the above-referenced report to reflect the resolution of this matter.

You also inquired as to our affiliation with Texas Utilities Company Political Action Committee. Texas Utilities Company (Company) has established three affiliated committees for the managerial employees of the Company and its subsidiaries. These affiliated committees are:

Texas Utilities Company Political Action Committee
Electric Service Political Action Committee of Texas Utilities Company
Power Political Action Committee of Texas Utilities Company

No connected organization was disclosed on Power PAC's recent amended Form FEC-1 as there was no change in its connected organization. The connected organization remains the Company. If the Form FEC-1 needs to be further amended to reflect this fact, please advise us and we will do so.


We note the similarity in the name of Texas Utilities Company Political Action Committee (which was organized prior to the formation of Power PAC) and the former name of Power PAC. The recent name change of Power PAC should help distinguish these two committees.
