
Dear Mr. Walker:

This is in response to your letter of March 26, 2002, in which you notified us that CNA improperly designated contributions to the Friends of Ray LaHond and Chris Cannon for Congress Committees during the 2002 cycle. We also inadvertently made an excessive contribution to the Elizabeth Dole Committee during the same cycle.

Upon review of your letter and our own records, we have notified each of the campaign committees referenced above and have requested a refund of the contributions at issue in writing. I am enclosing copies of the letter to each committee for your reference. Upon receipt of the refunded contributions we will make the appropriate amendments to our original report.

We thank you for bringing this matter to our attention and hope that by taking this corrective action the FEC will consider these matters favorably resolved.


We have been advised by the Federal Election Commission (FEC) that the CNA Financial Corporation Citizens for Good Government (CNA) has made an impermissible contribution to the Elizabeth Dole Committee.

CNA disbursed a check in the amount of \$1,000 to your committee on October 2, 2002, and designated this contribution to the general election. However, prior to October 2, 2002, and unbeknownst to CNA, the Lorillard Tobacco Company Public Affairs Committee, a committee with which CNA is affiliated, had already contributed \$5,000 to the Elizabeth Dole Committee. Therefore, CNA's contribution was impermissible.

Pursuant to FEC regulations, we are required to request that the Elizabeth Dole Committee refund CNA's \$1,000 contribution. The check should be made payable to CNA Financial Corporation Citizens for Good Government. Upon receipt, we will notify the FEC of our corrective action and amend our report submitted to them accordingly.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. We apologize for this inconvenience and look forward to supporting Senator Dole in her next campaign.


