Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 4 item(s):

1. Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of your report discloses \$770,834.29 in activity identified as negative MEMO entries that do not appear to correspond with any itemized transaction(s). Please be advised, a memo entry is used to disclose additional information about an itemized transaction and the amount of a memo entry is not included in the total receipts or disbursements for the report. Please amend your report to provide clarifying information regarding this activity. (11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a) and (b))
2. A review of the reports filed by your committee indicates that your committee received transfers from the "CALIFORNIA REPUBLICAN PARTY," "COLORADO REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE," and "REPUBLICAN PARTY OF NEW MEXICO," which have not been disclosed on their reports of receipts and disbursements. Please clarify if the transfers were received from the disclosed donors' federal accounts and amend your report(s) if necessary.
3. Schedule B discloses a credit card payment made 12/31/13 to "AMERICAN EXPRESS" totaling \$280,593.68. However, the sum of the memo entries provided identifying the original vendors associated with this payment totals \$287,263.69. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.
4. Schedule B supporting Line 29 discloses a disbursement for "RECOUNT
