Dear Ms. Sugarman:

This letter is in response to the request for additional information dated June 26, 2016.

1. Your letter indicates that the Committee disclosed one or more contributions that appear to exceed the limits set forth in the act. The Committee is aware of the contribution limits. In the case of an individual, if the contribution cannot be presumptively reattributed to a spouse or redesignated to a subsequent election, the Committee either sends a verified reattribution letter or refunds the excessive portion within 60 days of receipt. The Committee sends all presumptive reattribution and redesignation letters within 30 days or receipt and always gives the donor the option of making a change or requesting a refund. When the Committee receives contributions from other political committees that cause an excessive total, the Committee contacts the other political committee and requests a verified redesignation. If this is not received, the Committee issues a refund. The following is a response to each contributor listed in your letter:

Todd Caputos 5/23 \$250 contribution was re-attributed to his wife Amy Caputo on 6/28/2016. This was disclosed on the Q2 report.

Darlene Kerr had \$50 re-designated from the Primary to the General election on 6/9/2016. This was disclosed on the Q2 report.

Leonard Kolakowski had \$500 re-designated from the Primary to the General election on 7/8/2016. This will be disclosed on the Q3 report.

David Lysack had \$1,000 re-designated from the Primary to the General election on 6/30/2016. This was disclosed on the Q2 report.

2. Your letter indicates that the committee accepted contributions from possible prohibited entities. The contribution from Bond Schoeneck & King was verified as an LLC entity and partnership attribution has been requested.

3. Your letter indicates that the Committee has accepted contributions from unregistered organizations. The committee has verified that these contributions were made with federally permissible funds. A refund in the amount of \$1000 was issued to the Friends of Joanie Mahoney on 8/1/2016.
