## Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Your amended report discloses an increase in receipts totaling \$11,213.92 on Line(s) 11(a)(i) and 11(a)(ii) of the Detailed Summary Page and an increase in debts totaling \$160,501.62 on Line(s) 10 of the Summary Page from those disclosed on your original report.

The Commission notes the memo text attached to your report stating in part, "THE TOTAL RECEIPTS IN THIS AMENDED REPORT IS DIFFERENT THAN THAT OF THE ORIGINAL REPORT BY \$11,213.92. THIS AMOUNT IS AN ELECTRONIC FUND TRANSFER BATCH FROM USPS THAT WAS DEPOSITED IN OUR BANK ON 10/26/2012, BUT WAS INCORRECTLY CODED AS 10/01/2012. THE NUMBER OF DEPOSITS THAT MADE UP THE TOTAL WAS 2,394 TRANSACTIONS - TOO MANY TO ADJUST. AS A RESULT, WE DECIDE TO LET THE AMENDED REPORT SHOWN WITH A DIFFERENT RECEIPT AMOUNT." Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning this matter, your clarification and any additional clarification you may have will be taken into consideration. 11 CFR ?104.3

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due

date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
