Dear Ms. Reeve:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the notice referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Your report discloses \$0 or "NA" in total donations on line 9. Commission regulations require the disclosure of the identification of all donors who donated an amount aggregating \$1000 or more, since the first day of the preceding calendar year and ending on the disclosure date, to the person or entity making the disbursement. Identification for an individual is defined as the name and address. Please be advised that those paying for electioneering communications cannot use funds from national banks, corporations, foreign nationals, or labor organizations. Please amend your report to clarify the source of funds for the disbursements disclosed on this statement. If all donors did not aggregate over \$1,000 in the calendar year, please indicate this fact in your response. In addition, please provide a copy of the script for the communication listed in this report. (11CFR §104.20 (c)(7), 2 U.S.C. 441b(b)(2) and 441e(a)(2))

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated.

Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
