In response to your letter on the above referenced reports, please be advised that all payments reported on Schedule A, supporting Line 15, received from federal candidate committee(s) for goods and services provided by this Committee, are at the usual and normal charge for the goods and services provided. With respect to Rent/Occupancy our Committee charges candidate committee(s) the prevailing commercial rent for comparable rental space.

All the expenditures made for Telemarketing, Video Production, Printing, Polling, Catering/Facilities and Postage/Shipping are to support Committee activities, and are not made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates

Please be advised that the independent expenditures reported on Schedules E in support of federal candidates: Erskine Bowles, Ken Salazar, Betty Castor, Inez Tenebaum, Tony Knowles and Chris John were properly classified and reported as independent expenditures as defined under 2USC Section 431(17).

We have amended our 12 Day Pre-General Report, Schedules E disclosing independent expenditures, to include the signature of the treasurer.

With respect to the discrepancies in the reporting dates for independent expenditures shown in Schedules E, supporting line 24 and the dates of public dissemination included in the 48 hour reports; the Committee reported on Schedules E in the FEC report the actual date of the check to the vendor, not the date of public dissemination. We have amended our FEC report, Schedules E



There were no missing 48 hour notices, just the inability to reconcile total dollars as reported on Schedules E with the detail dollars reported on the original 48 hour notices.

Regarding the limitation on making coordinated party expenditures on behalf of federal candidates in Colorado (Ken Salazar) and Florida (Betty Castor), by letter dated June 28, 2004, we provided you with copies of agreements between this Committee and Democratic National Committee; and the respective state Democratic Parties designating this Committee as agent for making expenditures pursuant to 2 U.S.C section 441a(d). Regarding North Carolina (Erskine Bowles), please find enclosed a copy of the agreement, dated January 13, 2004, between this Committee and the North Carolina Democratic Party designating this Committee as agent for making expenditures pursuant to 2 U.S. C section 441a(d). Please note that even though the letter states \$878,214, the final amount for coordinated party expenditures on behalf of North Carolina is \$943,196.

We have amended our 12 Day Pre-General Report Schedule F, Line 25 to correlate the memo entries with the credit card payments.

Dear Chairwoman Allen:

This letter sets forth in full the agreement between the North Carolina Democratic Party ("the State Party") and the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee (the "DSCC") concerning 441a(d) spending authority on behalf of the Democratic Senate nominee in the 2004 general election for the United States Senate in North Carolina.

441a(d) Spending Authority

1. The State Party hereby designates the DSCC as the agent of the State Party for the exclusive purpose of making expenditures pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 441a(d) not to exceed \$878,214 (updated numbers will be forthcoming) on behalf of the Democratic nominee in connection with the general election for United States Senate in North Carolina held on November 2, 2004. The DSCC hereby accepts such agency.




2. In exercising its authority pursuant to the Agreement, the DSCC will comply with the limitations and other reporting requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder.

3. The DSCC will report to the Treasurer and Executive Director of the State Party the cumulative amount expended by the DSCC in connection with the general election under the delegation of authority provided under this Agreement and any other information with respect to such expenditures which the State Party may need for compliance with the requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder.
