Dear Ms. Holder,

Thank you for your telephone conversation with Randall Pence of the NCMA staff earlier today regarding your letter of November 15.

My staff has researched our records and have discerned that one of NCMA PAC's contributions to Senator Burns' primary election campaign was inadvertently reported as being allocated to the general election.

Per the guidelines provided in your letter, I have notified the Conrad Burns for U.S. Senate Committee to change its records to reflect the corrected record. NCMA PAC is informing you at this time of our corrective action, and I am providing a photocopy of the notification sent to the Burns committee. The redesignation of the 4/28/93 contribution will be disclosed as a memo entry on Schedule B supporting Line 23 of the report covering the period during which the redesignation is made.

Thank you for bringing this matter to our attention. We are pleased to respond as quickly and fully as possible to correct the record.
