-Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses offsets to operating expenditures from several entities (see attached); however, your report(s) does not appear to disclose a disbursement to, or on behalf of, these entities. Please provide clarifying information regarding this activity and amend your report(s) if necessary.

-Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses offsets to operating expenditures from apparent joint fundraising committees (see attached) which appear to be related to expenses paid by your committee for a joint fundraising effort. Please amend your report to clarify which disbursements these offsets are associated with.


-Please clarify all expenditures made for "Catering/Facilities," "Cons/Prof. Serv. Direct Mail Dev.," "Consult/Fundraising Profess. Services," "Data Processing Direct Mail," "Fees- Dev. Direct Mail," "Fees-Direct Mail Processing," "Postage," "Polling," "Printing," "Printing Direct Mail" and "Telemarketing" on Schedule B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedules B, E or F supporting Lines 23, 24 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate.

Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
