This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-The coordinated expenditure schedule (Schedule F) should disclose the following information: the identification of the designating committee, the payee's name and address, the purpose of the expenditure, the identification of the candidate supported, the office sought, state and district (if applicable), the date and amount of the payment and the aggregate general election expenditure total for each candidate supported. Please amend Schedule F by providing the identification of the designating committee, the payee's name and address, the identification of the candidate supported, the office sought, state and district (if applicable), and the aggregate general election expenditure total for each candidate supported. 2 U.S.C. §441a(d)


-Schedule F of your report discloses coordinated expenditures made on behalf of candidates and indicates that your committee has been designated to make coordinated expenditures by the Democratic National Committee or State Democratic Party. If your committee has been designated to make such expenditures by a State Democratic Party committee, please provide the name of the designating committee. If your committee has not been designated to make coordinated expenditures, they must be considered as in-kind contributions to the candidate(s) and be subject to the limitations of

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2 U.S.C. §441a. Please amend your report with clarifying information. 2

A response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
