This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:

1. Line 11(a)(ii) of the Detailed Summary Page discloses \$217,733.32 in unitemized receipts from individuals/persons other than political committees during the reporting period. Please clarify whether this figure includes any receipts from a single source that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. If this is the case, please amend your report(s) by itemizing the receipts on Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i). 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(2)(A) and (3)(A)
2. Please amend Schedule B supporting Line 23 by providing the address and state for each contribution made. 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3)(ii) and (v)
3. Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses a contribution(s) to "Robbie E. Allen"; however, you have also disclosed "Thomas H. Allen" for this transaction. Please clarify whether this was an earmarked contribution(s) made by your committee through "Robbie E. Allen" to this candidate. Please amend your report to clarify the ultimate recipient of this contribution(s).


Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the

due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
