Dear Mrs. Mitchell:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the notice referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Line 9 of the FEC Form 9 discloses \$162,500 in total donations. Schedule 9-A itemizes \$152,500 in donations received. If disbursements were paid exclusively from a segregated bank account consisting of funds provided solely by individuals who are United States citizens, United States nationals, or who are lawfully admitted for permanent residence under 8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(20), the name and address of each donor who donated an amount aggregating \$1,000 or more to the segregated bank account, aggregating since the first day of the preceding calendar year is required. (11 CFR §104.20(c)(7)) If necessary, please provide the required information on Schedule 9-A.


-Line 10 of the FEC Form 9 discloses \$200,000 in total disbursements/obligations. The electioneering statement shall disclose the amount of each disbursement, or amount obligated of more than \$200 during the period covered by the statement, the date the disbursement was made or the contract was executed, and the identification of the person to

whom that disbursement was made. (11 CFR §104.20(c)(4) If necessary, please provide a Schedule 9-B containing the required information.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
