Dear Mr. McCabe:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above. An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report discloses payments made to credit card companies. Payments made to credit card companies must identify in memo entries, the original vendors from which you have purchased an item or service if your payments to these vendors have exceeded \$200 this year. Please amend your report by providing the name and mailing address of the original vendor, along with the date, amount and purpose of each payment as required by 11 CFR §104.9(b) and clearly identify on the Schedule B, which credit card payment each memo entry relates to.

-Schedule B of your report discloses reimbursements to individuals for "GOTV phone calls," "Phone bank calls," "Reimbursement for election canvasses," "Reimbursement for GOTV expenses," "Reimbursement for GOTV supplies," "Reimbursement for SAHBA booth," and "Reimbursement for shredding expenses." Please be advised that when itemizing reimbursements to individuals for goods or services, if the payment to the original vendor aggregates in excess of \$200 in a calendar year, a memo entry including the name and address of the original vendor, as well as the date, amount and purpose of the original purchase must be provided. Please amend your report to include the missing information

and clearly identify on the Schedule B, which reimbursement each memo entry relates to. If itemization is not necessary, you must indicate so in an amendment to this report. 11 CFR §§104.3(b)(3)(i) and 104.9, and Advisory Opinions 1992-1 and 1996-20, footnote 3

-Schedule F of your report discloses coordinated expenditures made on behalf of a candidate(s). Please be advised that your committee must be authorized to make such expenditures by the State committee of your political party. If your committee has been designated to make such expenditures, please provide the name of the designating committee. If your committee has not been designated to make coordinated expenditures, they must be considered as in-kind contributions to the candidate(s) and be subject to the limitations of 2 U.S.C. §441a. Please amend your report with clarifying information. 2 U.S.C. §441a(d)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
