Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:

1. Schedule H4 discloses a disbursement(s) which is categorized as a fundraising expense(s); however, a Schedule H2 has not been filed to disclose the allocation ratio. All committees are required to allocate the direct costs of each fundraising event in which the committee collects both federal and non-federal funds. The costs are allocated according to the funds received ratio and reported on Schedule H2. 11 CFR §§106.6(d) and 106.7(d)(4). Please file a Schedule H2 to disclose the ratio for the fundraising event(s).
2. Schedule H1 of your February Monthly Report (1/01/07 – 1/31/07) indicates that the federal percentage for allocated administrative, generic voter drive and exempt activity costs is 15%. However, based on Commission calculations, the federal percentage used by your committee should be 28% for the 2007-2008 election cycle. Furthermore, Schedule H4 discloses allocated disbursements based on a 15% federal ratio. Please clarify this discrepancy and transfer the excessive non-federal amount back to the non-federal account, if appropriate.
3. Schedule H3 of your report discloses a \$0.00 transfer from the "DC Republican Committee State Account" for the Administrative category.

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Please amend your report to clarify whether any funds were transferred from your non-federal account to your federal account to cover the non-federal portion of Administrative costs disclosed on Schedule(s) H4.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
