This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Line 6(a) of the Summary Page represents the total cash-on-hand as of January 1, 1993. This figure should be the same on all the reports covering the calendar year. Please amend your report to clarify the change made in Line 6(a).

-Column B figures should be cumulative for a single calendar year. Please amend the Column B totals of your report to reflect 1993 activity only.

-Please provide the totals for Lines 20 and 30, Columns A and B, of the Detailed Summary Page.

-Your report discloses a returned contribution(s) from state and federal candidates totalling \$11,095 on Schedule A supporting Line 16. If the check written by your committee was not cashed, you should itemize the voided check on Schedule B supporting Line 23, or 29, as a negative entry. Line 16 should be used if the recipient committee cashed your check and wrote a refund on its account. Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy or provide clarification regarding these transactions.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this
