

This is a response to the letter dated September 17, 2008. The letter was not received by me until October 31, 2008.

Clarification was requested on 3 items.

1) Expenditures made for SJ catering, SJ Room rental, SJ Invites and SJ Speaker on Schedule B. SJ is abbreviation for our biennial event, named the Scoop Jackson Award event. We do raise money at the event for our PAC, to later contribute to candidates as decided by the Board. However, the event is not on behalf of any candidate(s).

2) The expenditures for Postage SJ 2008 Invites, Postage SJ 2008 Save Date, Save Date Cards SJ 2008 Graphic Design, and SJ 2008 printing on Schedule B. These expenditures are all related to the above mentioned Scoop Jackson Award event. The cards and invitations were created only for the event. No specific candidates or voter drive activity was included. They did not contain any express advocacy.

3) Refers to administrative expenses for rent, utilities, salaries, telephone, office equipment, and supplies. CityPAC does not have office space. It is a volunteer organization with no salaries. Assistance was received in managing the SJ event mailings and data maintenance, paid for with 2 checks to Nancy Kohn Consulting disclosed in the October Quarterly Report.
