Dear Mr. Vuong:

This letter responds to your letter to the House Conservatives Fund (HCF) dated October 7, 2009. If you have further questions, please do not hesitate to contact me at 703.548.8621.

We understand and conform to the rules set forth in 11 CFR 104.3 and 100.12. First, our original solicitations (whether by paper, internet, or telephone) include a clear and conspicuous request for contributor information, and they inform the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information.

Second, on a monthly basis a request for information is sent to all contributors for whom identification information is missing. The letter clearly asks for the missing information without soliciting a contribution, informs the contributor of the requirements of federal law, and includes a pre-addressed, stamped return envelope.

To the extent these efforts generate additional information for our reports, we file that information in Schedule A of our next regularly scheduled report, or we will file amendments to the relevant reports on or before our next regularly scheduled reporting date, depending on the circumstances and volume of the amendments.

We work diligently to collect all required information from donors, and we intend to file an additional amendment prior to November 20. In the future, we will file a Form 99 describing our "best efforts" compliance for reports wherein we appear to be missing certain contributor information.
