This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:


- Schedule A of your report discloses your committee has received \$58,500 in apparent earmarked contributions for several federal candidates. However, on Schedule B your committee discloses forwarding \$100,000 in earmarked contributions to these same federal candidates.

Please be advised, if the contributions passed through your committee's account, then a notation must be made which states this and each must be itemized on Schedules A and B, regardless of the amount. However, if the earmarked contributions were forwarded in the form of the contributor's check, then a notation must be made which states this and they should be disclosed as MEMO entries on Schedules A and B, regardless of the amount. For disclosure purposes, the name and mailing address for each contributor must be provided and where the contribution exceeds \$200, the individual's occupation and name of employer must also be itemized. 11 CFR §110.6(c)(1)(iv) Please amend your report accordingly and provide the apparent omitted Schedules A. Also, please clarify if the MEMO entry on Schedule A for Philip Berney dated 7/29/02 is an earmarked contribution. If so, please provide the apparent omitted Schedule B.

A response or amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in
