On November 15, 2000 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your November 20, 2000 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-When itemizing disbursements to federal candidates on Schedule B, you must provide the full name of the candidate, the office sought, as well as the state and congressional district, if applicable. Please provide the office sought (i.e. House, Senate, or President) for each disbursement on Schedule B, supporting Line 23.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by December 27, 2000. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions for time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will

be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
