Dear Mr. Boyd:

On November 15, 2000 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your November 30, 2000 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-You indicated in your amended Schedule B that the May 15, 2000 contribution in the amount of \$5,000 to Rogan for Congress was to be designated for debt retirement. However, campaign finance reports filed by Rogan for Congress to the Commission indicate that the committee did not have any debt arising from the expenses of the primary election.


Please provide clarification regarding any corrective action taken with regards to this contribution, and disclose any redesignations or refunds as necessary on the appropriate schedules. You may also submit a copy of the letter redesignating the contribution in question or a copy of the refund request in response to this letter.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by December 27, 2000. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration

in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions for time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
