Dear Ms. Brady:

Enclosed please find our response to the Federal Election Commission letter dated December 9, 2004 referencing the Ryan for Congress Campaign Committee's (ID Number: C00330894) October Quarterly Report (8/26/04 - 9/30/04). I respectfully submit the following information for verification and clarification purposes and in order to adequately comply with all the essential information required for full public disclosure of our federal election campaign finances.


As discussed, Schedule A of our report discloses two contributions, one from Conoco Phillips PAC (09/15/2004/ \$1000) and one from the American Occupational PAC (09/17/2004 / \$1000), that were incorrectly attributed to the Primary Election Period and clearly should have been attributed to the General Election Period. These two contributions do not exceed the amount of allowable contributions from the General Election Period and therefore will not need to be refunded or redesignated under current FEC compliance guidelines. An amended report will be filed accordingly by the January 10, 2005 response deadline to reflect the above changes.

As further discussed, our Committee failed to file 48-hour notices for two contributions. The two contributions were \$1000 from Mark Schueller (09/02/2004) and \$1000 from Express Scripts (09/10/04).

In reference to insufficient support information regarding Operating Expenditures on Line 17, Column A of the Detailed Summary Page and on Line 21, Column A of the Detailed Summary Page, it has become apparent that during the electronic submission of the October Quarterly Report the Schedule B's were inadvertently omitted and therefore not properly transmitted. An amended report will be filed accordingly by the January 10, 2005 response deadline which will include the missing Schedule B's.
