This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Itemized disbursements must include a brief statement or description of why the disbursements were made. Please amend Schedule B supporting Line(s) 29 of your report to clarify the following description(s): "member district matching." For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursements, please refer to 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3).

-Please clarify the disbursement(s) made for "member mailing-printing" and "member mailing-postage," on Schedule B supporting Line 29, specifically whether this disbursement(s) constitutes a communication to your restricted class which is exempt from the definition of contribution and expenditure under 11 CFR §114.3. If this is the case, the purpose of each disbursement should include the type of expense, the name, office sought, state, and district, if applicable; of each federal candidate identified in the communication, and a statement that the expense is for an internal communication to the restricted class (see Advisory Opinion 2000-3). Please amend your report to properly disclose this activity or provide clarifying information.

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
