Dear Ms. Zehr,

This is in response to your letter dated 3/10/06 which raised questions regarding the above referenced report:

- The "Payroll", "Insurance Payment" and "Allocable Portion 941 Tax Payment - 4th Quarter" and "Allocable Portion of the 4th Quarter 940 Tax" on line 21(a) were all in reference to employees who did not spend more than 25% of their compensated time on Federal election activities during this reporting period. The employee who did spend more than 25% of her compensated time on federal election activities's "Payroll" has been reported on line 30(b) as has the appropriate portion of the 940 and 941 taxes that are applicable to this employee.

- The payment for "Office Cleaning Expense" is not to an employee of the New Hampshire Republican State Committee. A 1099 Misc. tax form will be issued to this person in January 2007 to reflect their status as a nonemployee for the 2006 tax year.

- In researching the answer to this question, it was discovered that an amendment was needed to properly report the allocation amounts between our federal and non-federal accounts. This amendment was filed on 3/20/06 and is FEC-207220.
