This letter is in response to RQ-2 dated January 7, 2005. In this letter, we were asked to clarify certain expenses and which candidate they benefited. None of the expenditures on line 21 B were made on behalf of any candidate. All of these expenses were costs attributed for the general work of the CWPAC as described.

On the morning of January 11, 2005 I discussed by telephone this issue with Elizabeth Boody our Campaign Finance Analyst who was in agreement that our filings are correct. Based on this conversation and our understanding of the law, there is no reason to electronically file any amendments to our 30 Day Post-General Report.

This electronic statement is all that is required to notify the FEC that our filings are correct and no amendments are necessary. In the future we will file a memo text on our report to clarify our expenses.
