An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above. Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Any person, group of persons, or qualified non-profit corporation or organization who makes an electioneering communication must disclose their full name and address (and employer and occupation if necessary), as well as the date of public distribution and title of the electioneering communication. The full name, address, employer, and occupation of the Custodian of Records must also be disclosed. (11 CFR § 104.20(c)) Please amend your filing to include the employer and occupation of the Custodian of Records.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
