Gentlemen:

This letter is in response to your letter dated March 17, 2004, in which the Federal Election Commission requested a response regarding itemization information. In February 2004, Pro-Life Campaign Committee (the Committee) experienced technical difficulties and as a result its FEC files were destroyed. The Committee was able to recreate the files by downloading them from the Federal Election Commission. However, it seems that because of this technical problem, the reporting program did not properly transfer the beginning cash balance of the 2003 Year End Report from the 2003 Mid-Year Report. The Committee has rectified this discrepancy with the filing of an amended 2003 Year End Report filed March 26, 2004. This amendment should also correct the totals on Lines 7, 21 (b), 21 (c), 31 and 32 and Column B which were incorrect because of the technical issue.

Regarding the disclosure of contributions from individuals, on March 22, 2004, the Committee mailed the Federal Election Commission a sample of the original solicitation, reply forms and "best efforts" letters and envelopes used. This should demonstrate to the Federal Election Commission that the Committee's "best effort" has been made in order to obtain the required information.

The Committee feels that this response adequately addresses the issue raised in the Federal Election Commission's letter dated March 17, 2004. If the Federal Election Commission has any further questions, please feel free to contact the undersigned.
