Dear Ms. Reynolds:

This letter will confirm your telephone conversation of May 20, 1994 with Mr. Leigh Snell, Vice President of Public Affairs Support Services, Inc. (PASS), referencing your letter to me dated May 5, 1994 (RQ-5), concerning the March 1994 Monthly Report of the United Parcel Service Political Action Committee (UPSPAC), FEC ID No. C00064766. As Mr. Snell explained to you, PASS provides assistance to UPS with the administration of the UPSPAC.

I understand that, upon further review and discussion, it is your opinion that the \$350 and \$200 contributions by the UPSPAC to the Jon Kyl for U.S. Senate Committee, made February 9, 1994, for the purpose of supporting Mr. Kyl's 1994 primary campaign for the U.S. Senate seat in Arizona, were, along with previous contributions to Mr. Kyl's Senate primary race, incorrectly aggregated with contributions to the Jon Kyl Re-Election Committee, made in 1993 for the purpose of supporting Mr. Kyl's 1994 primary campaign for the Arizona 4th Congressional District Representative's seat.

I further understand that none of these contributions either individually or when aggregated with others made in connection with the same election, exceeds the limits on contributions set forth in 2 U.S.C. §441a(n). Therefore, I understand that no amendments to any of the reports referenced in attachments to your letter are required; that no refunds or redesignations of amounts contributed in connection with either election need to be made; and that no further actions need to be taken on the part of the UPSPAC in connection with this matter.


