
The calculation for Line 7, Column B is incorrect and should be \$680,544.61. The amount on Line 23, Column B should be \$423,025.00 and the amount on Line 30 and 31, Column B should be \$680,544.61.

In addition, your letter stated that the contribution of \$10,000.00 to MPAC exceeded the permitted annual contribution limitation. Please be advised that ILA-COPE has requested a \$5,000.00 refund from the organization. The letter requesting the refund is enclosed. Lastly, the contribution of \$2,000.00 to Kennedy for Senate 2000 has been reallocated from the Primary to General election, per your instruction.

I am Secretary-Treasurer of the International Longshoremen's Association, AFL-CIO, Committee on Political Education ("ILA-COPE"). On July 14, 1999, ILA-COPE contributed \$10,000.00 to your organization. Subsequently, we have been notified by the Federal Elections Commission ("FEC") that this contribution exceeds the permitted annual contribution amount by \$5,000.00, since your organization is registered with the FEC as a corporation and not as a political party committee. When we contributed money to your organization, we were under the impression that you were a multi-candidate political action committee. In view of this limitation, please refund \$5,000.00 by issuing a check payable to "ILA-COPE" and forwarding same to my attention at the address set forth above.
