I am writing in response to your letter of February 26, 1997 and John Gibson's follow-up letter of March 20, 1997. Specifically, I am responding to the fact that there appear to be two cases of over-contribution to the Kansas Republican Party - one involving the Snowbarger for Congress committee and one involving the Pat Roberts for Senate committee. I have done extensive research into what actually transpired and have come to the following conclusions:

Regarding the Pat Roberts for Senate contributions totalling \$5,350.00:

You note in your letter dated February 25, 1997 that it appears that the Pat Roberts for Senate campaign has exceeded campaign contribution limits as total contributions of \$5,350.00 are reported. In going back and researching what actually transpired between the Kansas Republican Party and the Pat Roberts for Senate campaign in 1996, I discovered that \$100.00 of the \$5,350.00 was actually a reimbursement by the Roberts campaign for room expenses paid for by the Kansas Republican Party at the 1996 Republican National Convention in San Diego (see enclosed copy of check). It was erroneously recorded as a contribution rather than a reimbursement. I will correct that entry on the 3rd Quarter amended report which I plan to file within the next few days. However, the balance (\$5,250.00) does indeed appear to be the total of two contribution checks (one for \$5,000.00 and one for \$250.00) -- thus exceeding campaign contribution limits. As I understand it, we have three options: (1) KRP can simply refund the Roberts campaign \$250.00 or; (2) KRP can ask the Roberts campaign to reallocate the \$250.00 elsewhere (nearly impossible since the check was a campaign committee check) or; (3) KRP can ask the Roberts campaign for permission to transfer-out the \$250.00 overage to our non-federal account. I have sent the Roberts campaign a letter to see what their wishes are regarding this overage and hope to hear from them soon. When I do, I will be sure to reflect their wishes in the FEC reports that I will be filing over the next several weeks.

Regarding the Snowbarger for Congress contributions totalling \$12,700.00:

1. A \$5,000.00 check from the Snowbarger for Congress committee was deposited into KRP's federal account on October 22, 1996. The check, dated October 16, 1996, was intended as a partial payment on a Voter ID telemarketing survey effort which was conducted in the 3rd Congressional District between October 19, 1996 and October 22, 1996. 40% of the survey's cost was to be paid by the Snowbarger for Congress campaign as 40% of the survey dealt specifically with that race. KRP was required to pay for the survey in advance. Thus, we requested that the Snowbarger for Congress campaign also pay a portion of their total cost in advance. Thus, the \$5,000.00 check which shows up on our Itemized Receipts report as a contribution was actually a prepayment of an obligation Snowbarger for Congress was incurring with the Kansas Republican Party. When I re-file the pre-general FEC report within the next couple of weeks, I will correct this erroneous entry.

2. After the above referenced survey was conducted, the telemarketing firm (Cherry Communications), sent us a statement reflecting our final charges for the Voter ID effort. The total bill for the 3rd Congressional District came to \$19,231.55. 40% of that total came to \$7,692.62. On November 5, 1996 the Snowbarger for Congress Committee sent the Kansas Republican Party another reimbursement check in the amount of \$2,700.00 to cover their outstanding balance for the Voter ID survey totalling \$2,692.62 -- resulting in a credit balance of \$7.38. This check was also erroneously recorded on our Itemized Receipts report as a contribution. It should have been recorded as a reimbursement.

3. Also on November 5, 1996 the Snowbarger for Congress committee sent the Kansas Republican Party a separate check for \$5,000.00. This check was intended as a contribution and has been accurately recorded that way on our Itemized Receipts report. The two previously mentioned checks were not contributions.

4. On the weekend prior to the general election (November 2-4, 1996) another telemarketing effort was conducted within the 3rd Congressional District. This effort was geared toward getting out the vote for Congressman Snowbarger and all other Republican candidates. Because Congressman Snowbarger was the only candidate mentioned by name in each of the calls, his campaign agreed to pay half of the cost of that effort. All told, 58,849 calls were made at a cost of 5.55 each. The Kansas Republican Party received a bill from Cherry Communications for \$32,366.95. Thus, Congressman Snowbarger's portion of this effort totalled \$16,183.47. We applied the \$7.38 credit (overpayment) from the Voter ID survey referenced above to this total. In addition, the Snowbarger for Congress campaign sent the Kansas Republican Party an \$8,000.00 check on December 31, 1996 as a partial payment for their portion of this effort. We have also deducted that amount from his total due. He now owes the Kansas Republican Party \$8,176.09 for the balance of his get-out-the-vote charges. I am enclosing copies of two invoices which I drew up today reflecting all of these transactions between the Snowbarger for Congress campaign and the Kansas Republican Party. I am quite certain that our former Comptroller failed to report the \$8,176.09 referenced above as an outstanding receivable on our year-end FEC report. I will do that when I refile that report within the next few weeks.


Other Year-End Receivables not reported on 1996 Year-End FEC Report:

1. Along the same lines, another receivable which I am certain did not show up on our year-end FEC report is from the Jim Ryan for Congress campaign and it also relates to the same Voter ID survey referenced above. In the Cherry Communications survey conducted in the 2nd Congressional District, Congressman Ryan agreed to pay for 30% of the survey's cost as 30% of that survey dealt specifically with that race. The Jim Ryan for Congress campaign did not make a downpayment on the survey as the Snowbarger for Congress campaign did. When we received the bill from Cherry Communications, the total due for calls made within the 2nd District came to \$22,624.55. Congressman Ryan's 30% amounts to \$6,787.37. To date, his campaign has not made any payments on that amount. Therefore, we should have also shown a receivable from the Ryan for Congress committee on our year-end FEC report in the amount of \$6,787.37 and yet I am quite certain that our former Comptroller failed to record that receivable on that report. When I refile our year-end FEC report within the next few weeks, I will record this amount as an outstanding receivable.

2. Finally, one more receivable that I have recently been made aware of is that the Sam Brownback for Senate campaign owed the Kansas Republican Party \$114.79 at the end of 1996. They shared the cost of a room with the Kansas Republican Party for an election night rally. Their portion of the expense came to \$114.79. This amount was paid by the Sam Brownback for Senate campaign on January 2, 1997. Thus at the end of 1996 it was still outstanding and should have been reported as such. It was not so I will correct that when I file the year-end FEC report for 1996.

I again apologize for the mess that those FEC reports are in. I will continue to work diligently to straighten them all out. Thanks for your patience.

Dear Leroy:

We recently received a letter from the FEC claiming that the Pat Roberts for Senate committee exceeded contribution limits to the Kansas Republican Party in 1996. The law allows a maximum contribution of \$5,000.00 from any individual or political committee to a state party committee per calendar year. From the FEC reports we filed in 1996, they totalled up contributions from your campaign totalling \$5,350.00. In going back and researching your 1996 contributions to the KRP, we discovered that \$100.00 of that amount was actually intended as a reimbursement for room expenses at the Republican National Convention in San Diego. It had been erroneously entered by our staff on our FEC reports as a contribution rather than a reimbursement. We are taking steps to correct that. The other \$5,250.00 is the total of two other contributions (one for \$5,000.00 and one for \$250.00). It does appear that we have exceeded the contribution limits by \$250.00.

The FEC has given us three options in dealing with this overage: (a) KRP can write you a refund check for \$250.00; (b) you can send us a letter requesting that we reattribute the \$250.00 overage to another individual or committee (but since the check was written on the Pat Roberts for Senate campaign account, this would likely not be allowable) or; (c) you can send us a letter allowing us to transfer-out the \$250.00 overage from our federal account to our state account. This last option does require written permission from you as we are required to file a copy of your letter with the FEC documenting the transfer-out. Please advise us how you want us to handle this overage.

I apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you. Please call if you have any questions. I look forward to hearing from you soon.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-The total listed on Line 6(c), Column B of the Summary Page appears to be incorrect. Please be advised that you should add the "Calendar Year-to-Date" total from your previous report to the current "Total This Period" figure from Column A to derive the correct Line 6(c), Column B total. Please amend your report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.

-Your calculations for Line 8, Columns A and B appear to be incorrect. FEC calculations disclose this amount(s) to be \$-13,640.29. Please provide the corrected total(s) on the Summary Page.

-Schedule A of your report (pertinent portion(s) attached) discloses a contribution(s) which appears to exceed the limits set forth in the Act. 2 U.S.C. §441a(f) and 11 CFR §110.1(d) preclude a committee from receiving contributions from another political committee or person in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year.

If the contribution(s) in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with the clarifying information. If the contribution(s) you received exceeded the limits, you must seek reattribution of the contribution pursuant to 11 CFR §110.1(k), transfer-out

If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedule B or F supporting Line 23 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §104.3(b)

-Your report disclosed a category of financial activity that has been reflected on the wrong line of the Detailed Summary Page. Transfers from affiliated Political Party Committees should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule A, supporting Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please


