Reference: 12-Day Pre-General Report (10/01/04-10/13/04)

In your letter dated November 19, 2004 you stated that the Calendar Year-To-Date totals were incorrect for lines 6c, 11a, 11d, 16, 19, and 20. I reran this report and found that there were some receipts that were dated for October 15th that were included in the report I sent on the 19th. There was also an adjustment made by the PAC Department for the period 10/1-13 after I sent the FEC report. The explanation for this adjustment is below.

National IFAPAC must run a Colorado AIFA Association contributor list starting 31 days after the general election and going to 31 days after the next general election. (For the 2004 election cycle, the date range will be December 6, 2002 to December 5, 2004.) For all contributors who give over \$1,000 aggregate during this time frame, the National IFAPAC is to keep the excess per a prior agreement with the state PAC because Colorado state law does not permit individuals to contribute over \$500 (the state PAC's share) during the time frame. The procedure to adjust the amounts that National IFAPAC keeps is normally done once a month at the closing of the calendar month's accounts. Because the pre-general FEC report was due prior to the end of the calendar month, the adjustments to four Colorado contributors (Shelley Rowe, Karen Braddock-Harrison, Donna Burrill and Edward Feiman) were not made until after the pre-general FEC report was filed. This error has been corrected in the amended FEC report.

The refund received by "Murtha for Congress Committee" was a refund dated 10/15/2004. Again, when I reran the report this receipt came off. It will be included in the Post General FEC Report.

The amended report will be sent by December 1, 2004.
