This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 item(s):

1. Your Amended April Monthly Report (3/1/11-3/31/11), received 8/8/11 discloses a substantial increase in the amount of disbursements from those disclosed on your original report. Please amend your report or provide an explanation to clarify why this additional activity was not provided with your original report. (11 CFR § 104.3)
2. Your report discloses \$8,215.97 from "Media Strategies & Research" in Offsets to Operating Expenditures of the Detailed Summary Page. Please be advised that if there are not corresponding expenditures for these entries, it may constitute an excessive or prohibited contribution. Please amend your report or provide an explanation for this apparent discrepancy. (2 U.S.C 434(b) & 11 CFR § 104.3(a) and (b))
3. The Commission notes the transfer-out on Schedule B to "Florida Democratic Party" for the apparent misdeposit of contributions originally intended for the non-federal account. Please be advised, contributions deposited in either the federal account or an account used for both federal and non-federal activity must meet the following conditions: the contributions are designated or expressly solicited for use in connection with federal elections and contributors are informed that their contributions are subject to the limits

and prohibitions of the Act. (11 CFR §102.5(a))

Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding the misdeposited funds, your prompt action in refunding or transferring out this amount will be taken into consideration.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
