Dear Mr. Morse:

I uploaded two 24-hour notices yesterday. The first contained a scrivener's error regarding the filing date. The report was correct in all other respects.

Approximately 20 minutes later, I uploaded a second 24-hour notice, based upon the exact same transactions, but with a corrected filing date.

However, due to the manner in which the FEC file software operates, even though I utilized the same six transactions for both reports - the very same line 24 disbursement entries - when I added these six transactions to the second 24-hour notice from the All Transactions window, even though both notices were generated utilizing the same six transaction entries, the software did not recognize this second 24-hour notice as an amendment of the previous notice. As a result, the FEC file software aggregated the entries in both notices for the purpose of generating the Calendar Year-To-Date Per Election for Office Sought figures.
