This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-The independent expenditure schedule (Schedule E) should disclose the following information: the name and mailing address of the payee, purpose of the expenditure, date of payment, amount of payment, the name and office sought of the federal candidate supported or opposed, signature of the treasurer, and notarized certification of the information provided. Please amend Schedule E by providing all omitted information. 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3)(vii) It appears that pages two and three have been omitted from this filing.

-2 U.S.C. §434(b)(6)(B)(iii) requires that the supporting schedule for disclosing independent expenditures be signed by the treasurer and certified by a notary public. This is to attest to the fact that the expenditures were not made in cooperation, consultation, or consent with, or at the request or suggestion of any candidate, or any authorized committee or agent of such committee. Please amend your Schedule E accordingly.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
