This memorandum is submitted in response to your inquiry regarding  
The National PAC report identified above.

\*The contribution to Texans for Senator John Cornyn was attributed to  
the Primary 2008 election in error. Our report has been amended to correct  
that error.

\*Regarding the concern related to Direct Mail Production and Postage costs,  
as we have noted in responses to similar inquiries in the past, our mailings  
are generic in nature. They do not contain express advocacy as defined  
under 11 CFR 100.22 They do not refer to a clearly identified Federal  
candidate and, therefore, they are not reported on Schedule B, line 21(b)  
in accordance with 11 CFR 106.6(f). Consequently, our original reporting  
is correct, and an amendment is unnecessary.

\*The duplicate Schedule H1 in our original filing appears to have been  
caused by a software error. We have eliminated it from our amended filing.
