Dear Mr. Averett:

This is in response to your letter dated August 4, 2000 requesting further information.

Item 1: A check of the corporate status of Westman Investments was made and it was determined that the company is not incorporated, but rather, a sole proprietorship. Attached is a copy of the check for your information.

Item 2: The contribution of \$250 from Ralph Anderson was a credit card contribution charged to his personal account and did not represent a corporate contribution. Although Schedule A shows Ralph Anderson, General Technology Corporation, in the address field, it was not a corporate contribution.

Item 3: The transfer of \$920 on 3/20/00 to RPNM Finance Account, reflected on Line 22, represented several unitemized contributions on 3/8/00 resulting from non-federal telemarketing. The costs for the telemarketing were paid for with non-federal funds and RPNM inadvertently deposited \$920 in unitemized contributions in the federal account instead of the non-federal account. As such, these contributions are included in the unitemized contributions for the report in question, and no amendment is required.

Please advise if further clarification is necessary.
