Attached please find amended Forms 9 for Electioneering reports filed by MoveOn.org Voter Fund on January 23, 2004, February 6, 2004 and February 13, 2004. These amendments incorporate communications that were disseminated in Nevada that, according to the database on the Federal Communication Commission website can be seen by voters in the state of California. California is currently subject to an electioneering window for the March 2, 2004 Presidential primary.

At the time that these reports were originally filed, MoveOn.org Voter Fund did not believe that these communications that were disseminated through Nevada television stations could reach California voters. Sec 11 C.F.R. § 100.29(b)(6). It has come to the attention of MoveOn.org Voter Fund that the FCC database for electioneering communications is now operational. Consequently, during the week of February 16, 2004, MoveOn.org Voter Fund checked all previously disseminated communications to ensure compliance with the Electioneering Disclosure rules. During this review, it was discovered through the use of the FCC database that communications that were disseminated in Nevada can be reached by 50,000 voters in the state of California. Consequently, MoveOn.org Voter Fund is filing these amended reports with the Commission.
