We are in receipt of your letter dated January 25, 2013 (copy enclosed), requesting additional information regarding the above referenced report. We offer the following response for your consideration.

Item 1

The Commission's notice states that the October Quarterly Report filed by Huck PAC (hereafter referred to as the 'Committee') did not provide adequate descriptions for the purpose of certain itemized disbursements. Payments labeled as "Consulting and Fundraising" were all related to the consulting services obtained for the Committee's fundraising activities. As requested by the Commission, the above referenced report has been amended to clarify the description of all disbursements previously described as "Consulting and Fundraising" on March 1, 2013 (FEC ID-858865). The Committee

has also amended the 30 day Post-General (FEC ID-858866) and January Year End Quarterly Report (FEC ID-858867) on March 1, 2013 to include the revised description.

Item 2

The Commission's notice also states that the above referenced report did not include memo entries for itemized disbursements to individuals for goods or services, whose payments aggregate in excess of \$200.00 in a calendar year. As requested by the Commission, the above referenced report has been amended to include the missing memo entries on March 1, 2013 (FEC ID-858865). The Committee has also amended the 30 day Post-General (FEC ID-858866) and January Year

End Quarterly Report (FEC ID-858867) on March 1, 2013 to include the missing memo entries.

We trust that the steps that we have taken to fully report the Committee's activities and the explanation provided herein will satisfy the Commission.
